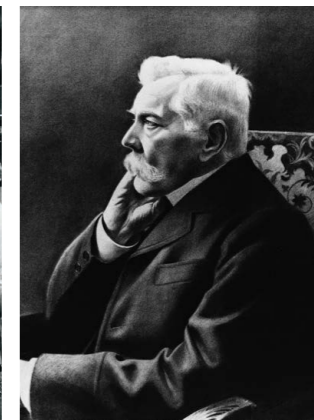

Since 1888

Johannes Auping was a hard-working blacksmith in Deventer. In 1888, the director of a hospital asked him to make a ventilating bed for the patients. He created a braided steel mesh mattress using a bean slicer and iron wire. Johannes Auping's smithy grew to become a mattress and bed manufacturer known for its excellent craftsmanship. In 1988, Auping was awarded the predicate 'Royal'.



Sustainable business operations

At Auping, we feel a strong responsibility to make the world healthier, safer and more liveable. For this reason, we are striving to make our entire product range fully circular by 2030 and ensuring all raw materials in our products are either renewable or recycled. In recent years, we have developed our beds and mattresses to take huge steps towards this goal.

Auping Essential

In 2012 we introduced the Auping Essential. The first fully recyclable bed in the world.

Auronde restyle

Since the introduction of the Auronde in 1973, over a million Auronde beds have been sold. In 2018, we set up our production process in such a way that we can repair and refurbish used Auronde beds to give them a second life. Even Auronde beds that are 50 years old can last another 50 years thanks to the strong materials and the high-quality repair work.

Auping Evolve

In 2020, we introduced the very first fully circular mattress in the world: the Auping Evolve. It's the perfect solution to the major waste problem caused by regular mattresses. The Auping Evolve was a breakthrough in the evolution of sleep technology and was rewarded with many prestigious design awards and sustainability prizes.

New generation of mattresses

Since this time, our range of mattresses has substantially expanded and become almost fully circular. With the introduction of the Auping Elysium and the Auping Elite, we now offer an increasing number of sustainable mattresses to provide the right support to each body type. After all, every person is different and every body is different. The world is changing and both we and our mattresses are changing with it.

Strong and sustainable

Every day, we work hard towards a better world in which nothing goes to waste and everything is reused for the next generation.

We always use high-quality sustainable materials as we believe you sleep better in a bed made with care and attention for the world around you.

Our Essential bed is made from 80% recycled aluminium. The 100% recycled aluminium legs can be recycled time after time, for example, as high-quality chair legs.

Strong and sturdy beech wood is the basic material used for our Auronde and Noa. The beech wood of the Auping Auronde and the Auping Noa is made up of 15 thin layers that have been pressed together. This process makes the wood incredibly strong and greatly extends the lifespan of our beds.

Our latest bed, the Auping Noble, is made from solid oak wood. Its immensely robust quality will serve generations to come.

This is how Auping makes dreams come true and how Auping brings rest to the world.

The rounded corners have a soft feel and reflect great craftsmanship and quality. There is a beautiful layered effect as the tables are attached to the bed and the soft lounge cushions on the broad headboard rest upon the wooden platform. This helps add balance to a timeless design."

"I wanted to make a bed for Auping that would last for many years and that would be easy to assemble and disassemble." At that time, many beds were made of particle board, which damaged easily. So de la Haye opted for strong beech wood and came up with the characteristic aluminium connectors, which are an important part of the design.

Eva Harlou is a Danish architect who graduated from the Aarhus School of Architecture in 2003. Her Scandinavian feel for form, functionality and beauty is clearly reflected in all of her designs. 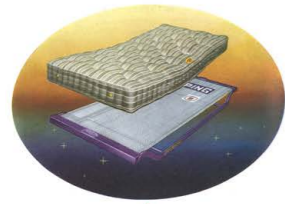

Sanitary undermattress

This type of mesh base without rivets was the first that could be produced in colour. You could choose between the colours gold, red, green, and purple. It could be made to any desired dimensions. The brackets made it easy to fit inside a crib or bedstead.

Cleopatra

The sofa bed Cleopatra breaks with the traditional design of all previous beds. A.R. (Dick) Cordemeijer was asked by Auping to design 'something beautiful'. The Cleopatra meant true industrial design. It was the first bed to be mass-produced and its elegant design is crafted from steel with a wooden ornament.



Auronde

The Auronde is made of beech wood and has distinctive aluminium details and curved legs. Frans de la Haye wanted to make a durable and modern bed. Not only a fully functional bed, but also one that could serve as furniture, used to read a book or watch tv.

Ariadne

The Ariadne is the first bed designed by Friso Kramer. The frame is made of steel and the headboard and footboard are made of wood with rounded corners. In addition, the bed has slender, tapered legs. A typical 1960s design.



Noa

Noa was designed by Danish designer Eva Harlou. The Auping Noa is designed to be modest with natural materials and clever details – all perfectly in keeping with Scandinavian design tradition. Made from sturdy beech wood with an oak veneer, this airy design has a serene look.



Essential

The Essential was designed by the Berlin design duo Köhler Wilms with the aim of creating a beautiful, timeless, and sustainable bed. It is sustainable due to the use of recyclable materials and its timeless design.



Noble

Johan van Hengel is the creator of the Noble – a timeless and regal bed crafted from solid oak wood with exquisite lounge cushions and gently rounded corners. It's truly a bed for the generations.

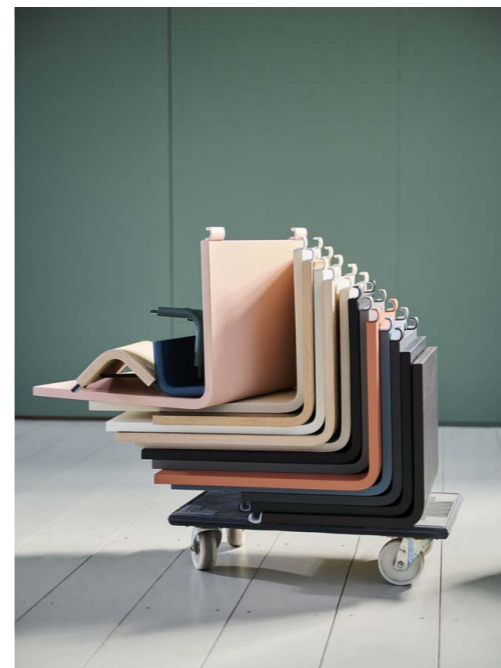

The round shapes, which were very innovative at that time, have maintained an exceptionally timeless look. The characteristic aluminium connectors are an important part of the design, as is the wide range of colour choices. The choice of the many colours and the 3 accessories make the bed complete. The rear element of the Auronde is a valuable accessory consisting of 2 nightstands connected to the headboard of the bed. This gives you the option to keep everything you want close to you at night, such as a nightlight.

The Auronde can be combined with a beautiful headboard in two heights. The Auronde headboard has beautiful, rounded corners and matches the bed perfectly. The Auronde bedside table also has rounded shapes, is made of bent beech plywood and can be placed anywhere on the bed. Place it next to the bed or at the foot end, for example. The angle of the bedside table is just under 90 degrees, so you can easily move it around.

The Auronde is made from exceptionally strong beech. For the finish, you can choose from 10 different colours of lacquer, 6 stains on oak veneer, or a walnut veneer. Choose a matching or contrasting colour for the aluminium details.

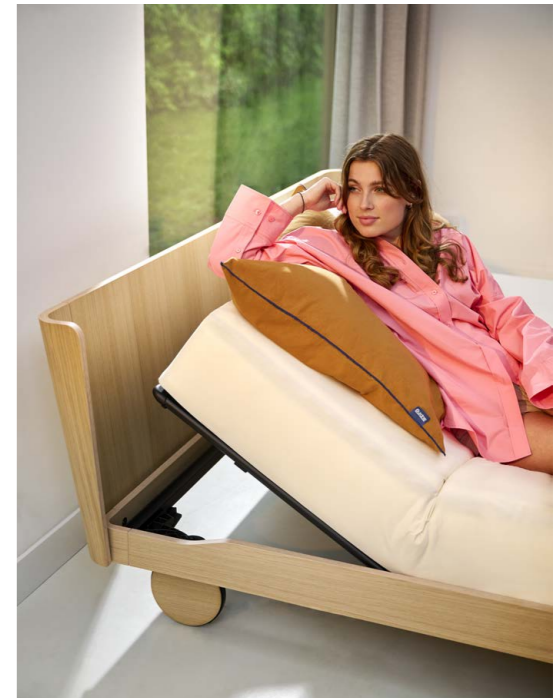

What makes the Noble so different from our other beds is the two large cushions on the headboard. They're very tall and as wide as the mattress, making them extremely comfortable to lean back on. Of course, you can also choose your very own cushion covers to perfectly suit your tastes. The oak wood can be stained in one of six colours: Solid Oak, Soft White Oak, Dark Blue Oak, Coffee Brown Oak, Chocolate Brown Oak and Midnight Black Oak. 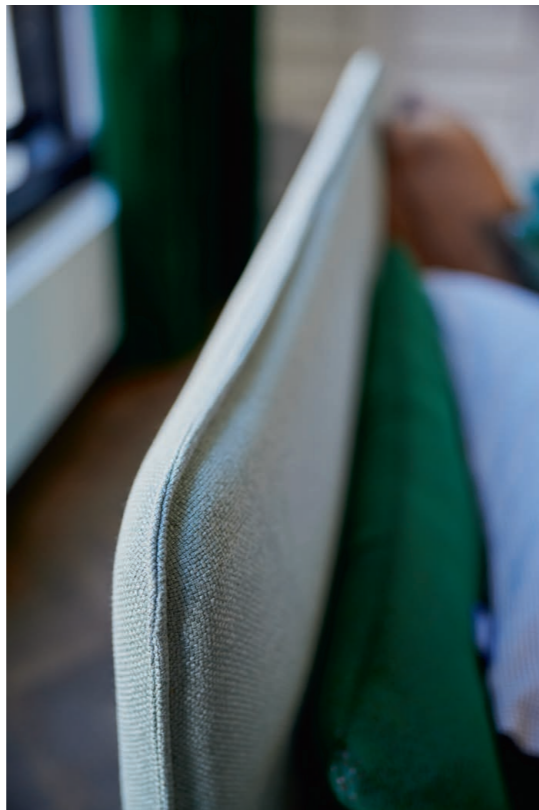

All four of the headboards are designed by the Auping Design Studio in Deventer. The Mute headboard is a peaceful headboard with subtle cord piping all around. This headboard fits into practically any bedroom but it's far from boring. Wink is Mute's rebellious little brother. The headboard frame has flat-stitching all around; the points are slightly raised for a playful effect. Bold is very solid and sturdy, and is very suitable if you want to make a statement in your bedroom. Line is a graphic and cosmopolitan headboard due to the vertically stitched pattern.
